

Allemannites GRÜN, 1975

Description:

A new genus of the subfamily Retecapsoideae with the following features: The central area has a striated crossbar aligned with the axes of the ellipse. In each of the resulting quadrants there is a grid of unstriated lateral bars, as in the genus *Polypodorhabdus*. The spaces between these lateral bars are subdivided by additional small elements. The resulting perforations lie close to a straight line which is generally perpendicular to the lateral bars. The perforations of the genus *Cretarhabdus* are situated in concentric rings around the central process. The base of a solid spine is always present.
