

**Arkhangelskiella** VEKSHINA, 1959

**Description:**

Discoliths elliptical with tapered or broadly oval ends, sometimes round. Concave, overall shape, from carinate to cup-shaped. The edge area is thickened and two-layered. The cup-shaped forms terminate in a papilliform projection on the convex side. The presence of ribs on the plate of the coccolith is characteristic for the manipule. The structure is formed of ribs and dot-pores between them.
