

## ANNULUM

Fombella 1978

**Diagnosis:** Vesícula plana de la cual la parte central del núcleo tiene una periferia circular a subcircular, limitada por un anillo distintivo de color más oscuro. Este anillo puede carecer de ornamentación o llevar unos elementos radiales de tipo filoso, flagelar o lancetiforme. La superficie del área intra-anular es variadamente ornamentada: lisa, coposa, aterciopelada.

**Type species:** *Annulum difuminatum* Fombella 1978, p. 249, pl. 3, fig. 18, 19.

junior synonym of *GRANOMARGINATA* according to Moczydlowska 1991 p. 57 who regarded *A. difuminatum* a jr. syn of *G. squamacea*.

# ANNULUM

Fombella 1978 emend

Martin in Martin & Dean 1983 p. 359

Emended diagnosis: Central internal body of flattened form, with more or less circular outline. Numerous fine, tangled, anastomosing filaments are arranged radially over the whole surface of the central body; they form a continuous median layer which appears spongy and fluffy in transmitted light and 'vermicelli-like' under the scanning electron microscope. This intermediate layer is itself surrounded by a very fine, transparent, external membrane.
