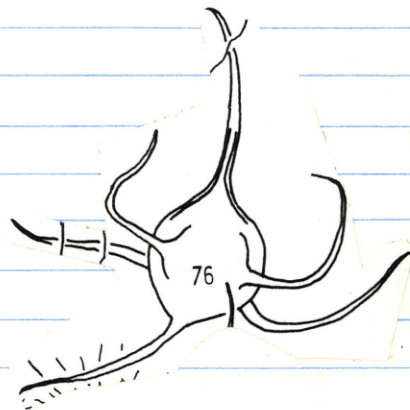
ECMELOSTOIBA Wicander 1974, p. 20: "Vesicle elliptical to subspherical, inflated; processes simple, broad based, tapering to a sharp point, hollow, opening into and communicating freely with vesicle interior; wall of both vesicle and processes laevigate, moderately thick; excystment by splitting of vesicle wall". (E. symmetrica: Wicander 1974, pp. 20-21, Pl. 8:9-11).- text-fig. 3:76.

Junior synonym of *Micrhystridium* (arguments: Chapter 4:2b,8).

Wicander 1974

differs from *Pulvinophæridium* and *Estiastra* in possessing a distinctive vesicle with pointed processes

jr. syn. of *MICRHYSTRIDIUM* according to Eisenack et al. 1979a  
and by Cramer & Diez 1979  
retained as separate genus by Wicander 1983
