

# LOBOTHECA

Vavrdova 1986

Type species: L. ambigua (Burmann 1970) Vavrdova 1986 p. 352

Diagnosis: Relatively large-sized vesicles of fusiform shape. Apical part protrudes very gradually into slowly tapering horn. Antapical part provided with one or two asymmetrical outgrowths of conical shape. Wall thin unilayered, smooth or with minor sculpture. Excystment opening unknown.

Discussion: ... The genus differs from the other leiofusids in asymmetrical horns of strikingly unequal size.
