

Actes Soc. Linnéenne Bordeaux, v. 104, sér. B, no. 29, p. 12

Type species: Virgatasporites rudi Combaz, *ibid.*, pl. 1

Diagnosis: "Circular form, generally with the appearance of a spore. Trilete mark uncertain. The proximal face is characterized by a system of low radial striae, that tend to anastomose. Exine rather thin. Diameter: 28-30 μ ."

Reminiscent of Emphanisporites, but with uncertain trilete mark; also, the radial striae are less definite, and here tend to anastomose.

Monotypic.

Description of type species: Exine thin, smooth; proximal face with a network of straight radial striae that may anastomose to a greater or lesser degree.

Tremadocian; Algeria.
