

Citrocalculus TROELSEN & QUADROS, 1971

Description:

Diagnosis: Calcareous body, subellipsoidal, divided radially into five segments, each with a different crystallographic orientation.

Remarks:

The pentalithic structure refers *Citrocalculus* to the Braarudosphaeraceae, however, no other described genus of that family has subellipsoidal skeletal elements.
