

## BIPATELLIFERA

C. Singh 1983

**Diagnosis:** Bipolar forms with a cylindrical body and a shallow, dish-like structure at each pole; dish-like structures composed of closely spaced short, solid rod-like processes, arranged in a circle at each pole and linked distally by ring trabeculae; processes joined at the base by a low circular ridge; tips of the processes usually expanded; most specimens entire, rarely opening by a slit-like rupture at the base of dish-like structure at one pole

**Type species:** *B. clathrata* Singh 1983, p. 16f, pl. 62, fig. 5-9 (holotype 5-6)
