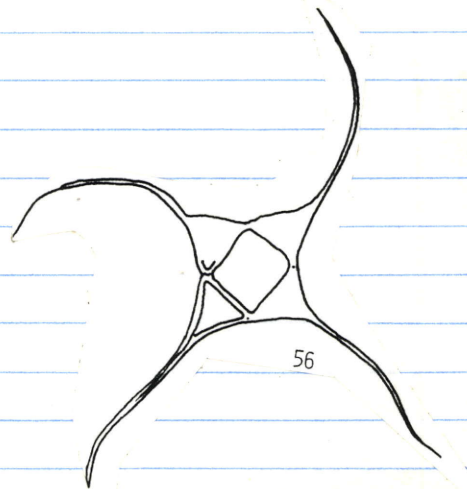

DEFLANDRASTRUM Combaz 1962, p. 1977: "Cenobitic organism composed of four elongatedly triangular cells which are located in the same plane, are united by their bases and delimit a central lumen that is neatly circular or roundedly quadrangular; the tops of the cells are drawn out into an often very much prolonged spine which is hair-like, curved and often broken".
