DEMORHETHIUM Loeblich & Wicander 1974, p. 708: "Vesicle spherical to subangular in outline, with a variable number of short, stout, conical processes that taper little; distally processes are blunt and terminate in a crown of small flexible spinules; processes do not communicate with the vesicle; wall thin, that of the vesicle covered by a densely packed array of tiny, variously shaped projections resulting in a spongy wall surface, process walls smooth but commonly striate proximally and ornamented with tiny scattered verrucae; no pylome or excystment mechanism observed".
