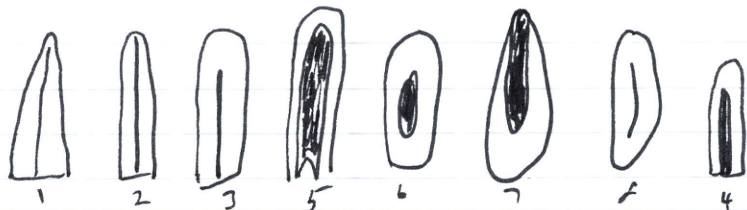


# DERVENTIA

Lakova 1997b p 4&3

Organic-walled microfossils of unknown biological affinities, cylindrical, conical, cylindro-conical or ellipsoidal transparent, smooth, with a dark-brown central channel or central body at axial position and of different length and width compared to the total dimensions one end is tapering or bluntly oval the other end is oval or broken. always fairly to strongly elongated the relation of total width to total length  $w$  being generally  $0.14$  to  $0.28$
