

ELEKTORISKOS Loeblich 1970, p. 717: "Circular to subcircular central body, wall apparently single layered, psilate, chagrenate to granulate with numerous slender, flexible but solid processes which do not communicate with the interior of the central body". (E. aurora: Loeblich 1970, pp. 717-718, Pl. 12:A-D).- text-fig. 3:79.

(Junior synonym of Comasphaeridium (arguments: Eisenack et al. 1973, p. 245); retained by Wicander & Wood 1961 and by Wicander 1963

Playford in Playford & Dring 1961 distinguishes from *Comasphaeridium* in lacking 'densely crowded hair-like processes'

Playford follows Loeblich in separating *Elektroniskos* from *Filiosphaeridium* on absence of distal expansion of processes.
