

# INDIGESTOSPHERIDIUM

Zang and Walter 1992a

p. 61

Type species: *I. adiakritum* Zang & Walter 1992

Diagnosis: Vesicles large; processes heteromorphic; one hair-like form covered by a thin outer membrane; and the other spinose forms, discrete, hollow, open or closed at the tip, communicating with the vesicle cavity

Remarks: Its processes are heteromorphic and highly differentiated. One form is hair-like arising from the robust inner wall to support a thin outer membrane resembling *Cymatosphaeroides* and the other spinose form is hollow, separate, open or closed at the tip and communicating freely into the vesicle cavity, which is similar to *Trachylhystrichosphaera*
