

LABYRINTHOSPHAERIDIUM

Uutela & Tynn, 1991 p. 71-72 (Type species: *L. curvatum* U. & T. 1991 p. 72
pl 14, fig 143)

Diagnosis: The small, hollow, spherical to subspherical vesicle is ornamented with irregular low ridges, which form a wider or narrower labyrinthic pattern. An excystment structure is present as a medial split.

Comparison: The genus resembles *Dictyotidium* which has lacunal areas as polygons and is not labyrinthic. The genus *Cymatosphaera* has an even more regular polygonal pattern than either this genus or *Dictyotidium*.
