LANVEOCIA Deunff 1978, p. 114: "Central body spherical with hollow processes of variable length, which bear longitudinal crests. These crests are especially developed at the thickened base of the processes. The process tips end in an organic structure which is more or less blunt. All hollow processes are closed at their bases and their interiors do not communicate with the inner part of the body. The surface of the body is covered by an interwoven ornament of 'vermicules'; this net is commonly quite distinctly developed, but it may occasionally be rather vague.
