

# LATOPORATA

LATOPORATA Naumova 1950, nomen nudum, Naumova 1975: "Vesicles rounded to elliptical of varying size, but always double-walled in optical section. In the central part of the vesicle there is a rounded to oval - occasionally irregularly shaped-pylome which is bordered by a thick collar. The diameter of the pylome is one-third to one-half of the vesicle diameter. Vesicle surface smooth or with minor sculpture". (Latoporata serrata (as Archaealetes serratus): Naumova 1950, p. 188, Pl. 5:5).- text-fig. 3:120-121.

From the charming drawings it appears that at least the process-bearing forms of Latoporata should be placed in synonymy of Priscogalea and the genera issued from it; once the palynological augurs have divined the meaning of the remaining drawings of Naumova's Latoporata species, it seems probable that most (and surely the veiled forms) will be found to be synonymous with western taxa.
