1963 *Baltesphaeridium denticulatum* S.-W., p. 458, pl. 1, fig. 4; text-fig. 13

1970 *Diexallophasis denticulata* (S.-W.) Loeblich, p. 715-716, fig. f A-E, 9 A-C

junior synonym of *DIEXALLOPHASIS remota* according to Playford 1977 p. 19

- Loeblich 1970a: Middle Silurian, New York, USA
- Eserack et al 1973: range Late Llandoveryan - late Neogenic (or Early Emurian)
peaks in Wenlockian and Ludlovian
slightly echinate forms range highest, scarcely echinate forms
die out in Gedinurian
