

STICCASPHERIDIUM

Type species: *S. incertum*

Diagnosis: Vesical spheroidal: processes stick- or club-like, commonly of uniform width, obtuse or semi-circular distally; occasionally small conical spines observed

Remarks: *Pulvinosphaeridium antiquum* is similar but its vesicle is c. 70 μm in diameter and its processes widened at the base and tapering at the tip. Processes of *Sticcaspheeridium* are narrow at the base, and untapered at the tip.
