

# THYMADORA

Clendening & Wood 1961

Diagnosis: Vesicle hollow, subspherical to ellipsoidal, rarely spherical in outline. Vesicle wall apparently ~~monolayer~~ unilayered; two, rarely three, unipolar processes extend from a slight protuberance of the vesicle surface and processes may be ornamented with minute granules.

Remarks: An excystment structure, possibly a pylome, located diametrically opposite the processes. Additional examination with the scanning electron microscope must be undertaken to correctly elucidate the true nature of this structure.
