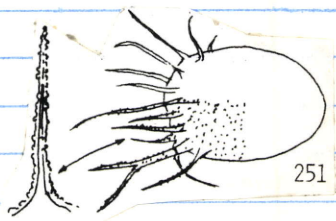

TRUNCULUMARIUM Loeblich & Tappan 1976, p. 305: "Vesicle oval in outline, with variable number of processes confined to one pole; processes hollow and communicate freely with the vesicle interior, commonly simple, rarely bifurcated; wall thin, surface of vesicle with grana, processes with grana, and small spinules and tubercles; excystment by simple rupture and splitting of the vesicle wall".
