

Parastomiosphaera NOWAK, 1968

Description:

The name *Parastomiosphaera* is proposed for unilocular microfossils possessing tests composed of two layers, an outer one with a spherulitic and an inner one with a fibrous structure.

Remarks:

Double structure of test was responsible for *Parastomiosphaera* being hitherto included either to *Stomiosphaera* WANNER (cf. Bórza, 1964), or to *Cadosina* WANNER (cf. Nagy, 1966). However, the present microfossils do not agree with both.
