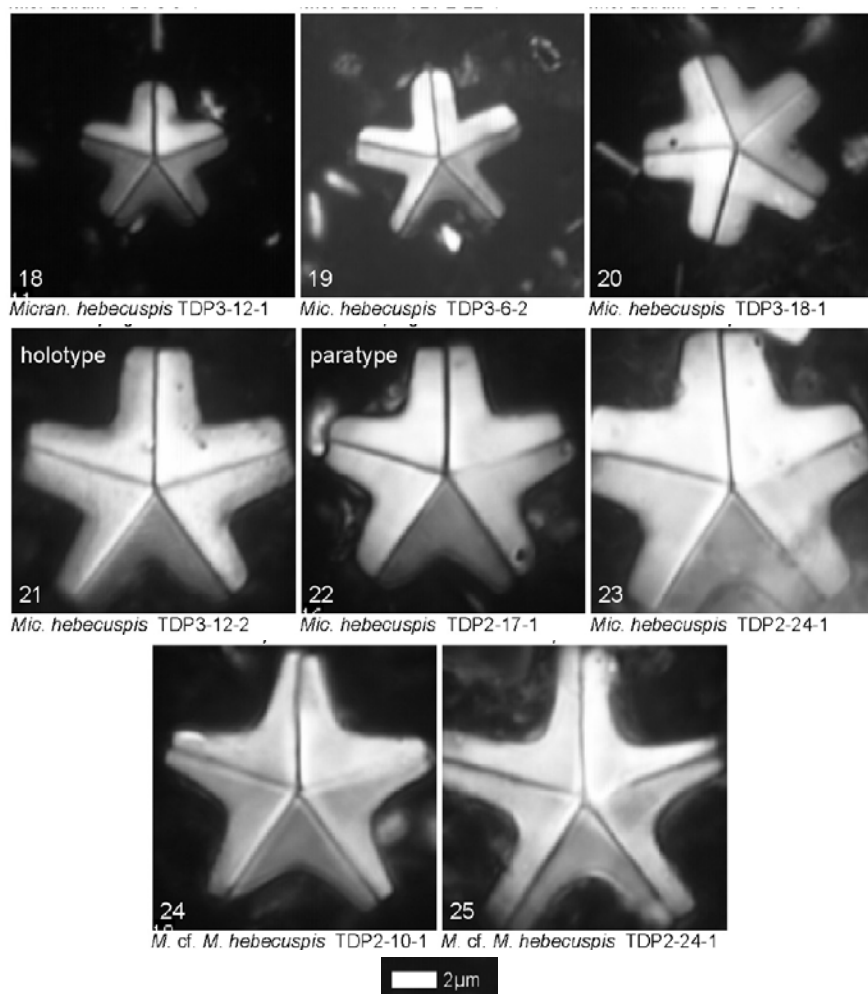


152. *Micrantholithus hebecuspis* Bown (2005)



Pl. 35, figs 18-25

**Derivation of name:** From *hebes*, blunt, and *cuspis*, meaning point, and referring to the distinct shape of this pentolith.

**Diagnosis:** Large *Micrantholithus* with deeply indented sides and blunt, flat-ended apices.

**Dimensions:** L = 7.1-12.7 μm.

**Holotype:** Pl. 35, fig. 21.

**Paratype:** Pl. 35, fig. 22.

**Type locality:** TDP Site 3, Mpara Hill, Tanzania.

**Type level:** Lower Eocene, Sample TDP3-12-2, 27cm (Zone NP11).

**Occurrence:** NP11-15c; TDP Sites 2, 3.
