

148. *Nicholasia Lees (2007)*

Type species: *Nicholasia baileyi* gen. et sp. nov.

Derivation of name: After Dr. Chris Nicholas (Trinity College, Dublin University), sedimentologist, structural geologist and TDP co-chief.

Diagnosis: Delicate-looking holococcoliths that, in side view, have the outline of a hollow isosceles triangle. The base-plate is virtually invisible. Where the spine joins the base-plate, there are two bright spots.
