

Placolithites HAQ, 1971

Description:

Diagnosis: Large placoliths composed of narrow elliptical rims consisting of a large number of tiny laths bundled together, parallel to the rim on the distal side but diagonal to the rim on the proximal side. Large central area, usually, empty due to falling out of central structure in most specimens. Length 12-15 μ .
