

Pseudoemiliana GARTNER, 1969

Description:

Elliptical to nearly circular placolith. The shields may be solid, or may be perforated by a few or numerous radial slits which are located between adjacent shield elements. The center may be open but more commonly is blocked by a lacy grillwork.

Ellipsoplacolithus lacunosa KAMPTNER, 1963.
