

Pseudotriquetrorhabdulus WISE & CONSTANS, 1976

Description:

Diagnosis: Elongate spine-shaped object composed of radial keels of variable size oriented parallel to the long axis; ends pointed or truncate. The keels are not strictly symmetric about the long axis.

Remarks:

This genus is distinguished from *Triquetrorhabdulus* MARTINI, 1965 and *Litbra-
phidites* DEFLANDRE, 1963 by its greater number of keels and/or their lack
of strict radial symmetry about the long axis.
