

199. *Singanoa* Lees (2007)

Type species: *Singanoa scapus* gen. et sp. nov.

Derivation of name: After Dr. Joyce Singano (TPDC, Dar-es-Salaam), micropalaeontologist, general facilitator and 'mother' of the TDP team.

Diagnosis: Nannolith of various lengths, comprising four narrow blocks, arranged end-to-end in two pairs. Diagonal blocks go into extinction together, and a dark extinction area in the centre gives the appearance of a constriction in the nannolith (like a scroll tied at the middle).
