

216. *Tanzanella* Lees (2007)

Type species: *Tanzanella bownii* gen. et sp. nov.

Derivation of name: After Tanzania, where the genus is described from.

Diagnosis: Holococcoliths with a complex structure, as seen in side view. In XPL, rotated to 45°, the rim and proximal plate are thin, birefringent and clearly visible. Encased within these is a blocky structure, from the distal surface of which emanate four 'prongs'.
