

244. *Youngilithus Bown (2005)*

Type species: *Youngilithus oblongatus* sp. nov.

Derivation of name: After Dr. Jeremy Young (Natural History Museum, London, UK), nannopalaeontologist.

Diagnosis: Geometrically-shaped, non-birefringent holococcoliths, typically possessing lateral rim spines and central-area bars.
